How to get to the EPS

The Escuela Politécnica Superior (EPS) is in the campus of Cantoblanco. This campus is located around 15 km from the city of Madrid. There are several ways to get to the campus.

By taxi

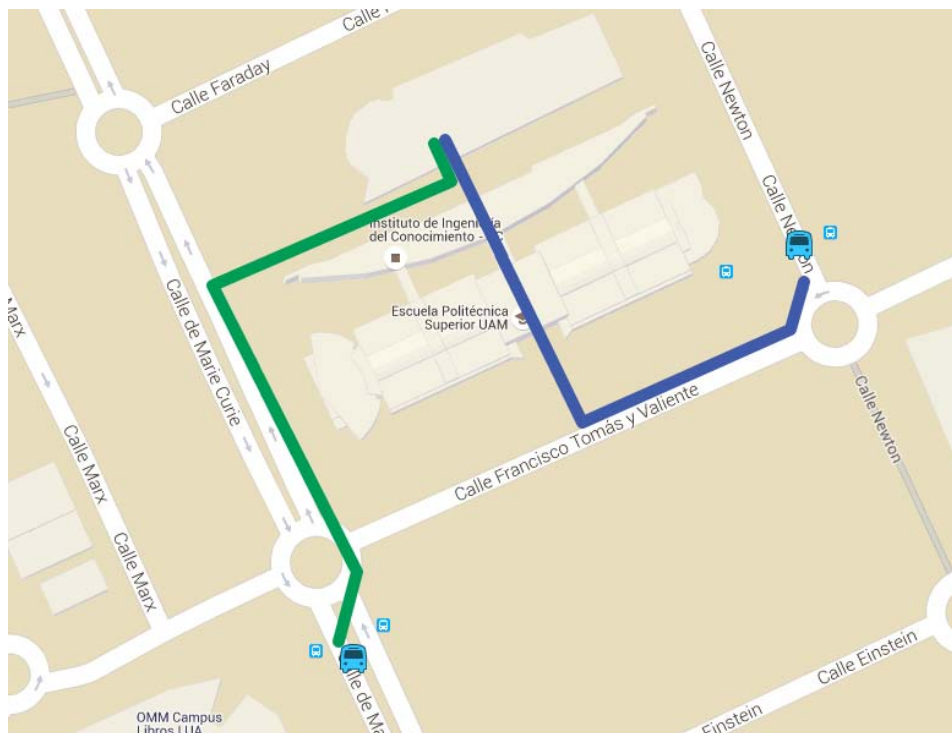
The address of the EPS is:

It is important to say to the taxi driver that you want to go to the “Universidad Autónoma”. There are several universities in Madrid, and this will help.

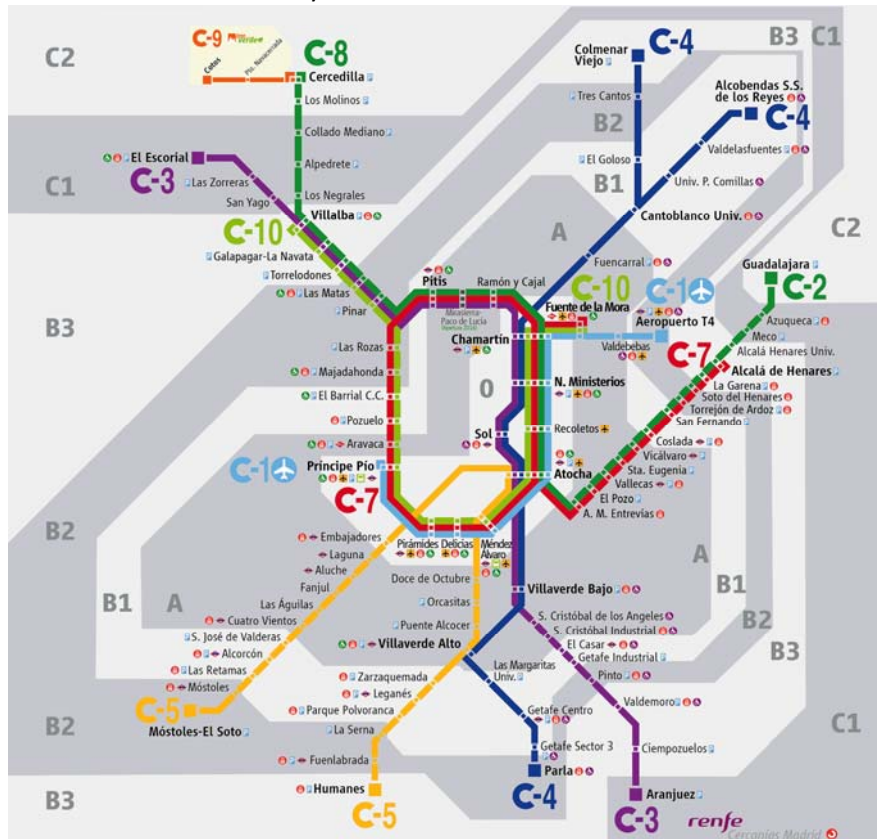
By bus

The line 714 gets to the Universidad Autónoma de Madrid and departs from Plaza Castilla’s bus interchange (level -1, the subway entrance is in level -2). The price of a single ticket is 2€ and you can buy the ticket on the bus from the driver. However, they usually only accept up to 5€ or 10€ banknotes. There are two bus stops near the EPS:

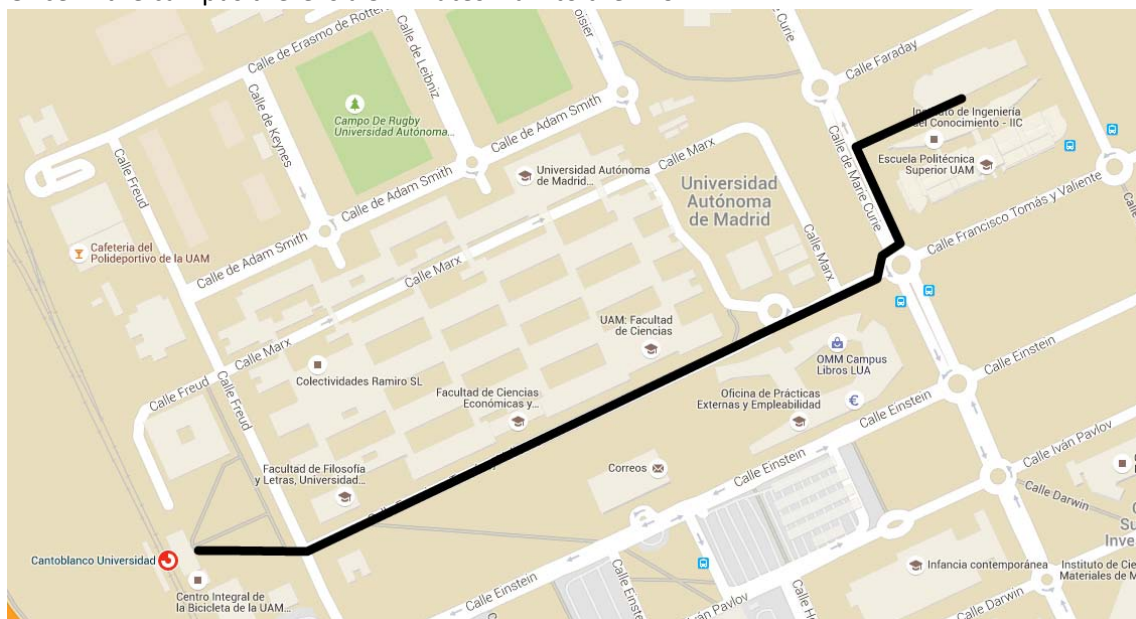


By train:

The commuter train gets to the Universidad Autónoma de Madrid. The train University's train station is "Cantoblanco Universidad", which belongs to the C-4 line of the commuter train. The prize of a single ticket is 1.85€ from the city Centre station (Sol, Nuevos Ministerios and Chamartin). You can get to these commuter stations using the subway. The name of the commuter's stations and the subway's are the same.



Once in the campus there is a 5 minutes walk to the EPS.



Once in the EPS, how to get to the MSE Meeting

The meeting will take place at the “Building C - Joseph Fourier”. The welcome desktop will be located at the entrance of the Building. The meetings will take place at the “Salón de Grados” and the “Sala de Juntas”.
